

1. Net Zero Commitment

Vatix Limited is publicly committed to achieving net zero greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions across its UK operations by 2050. This plan sets out our current emissions baseline, our reduction targets, and the actions we are taking to progress towards that commitment. Our commitment covers Scope 1, Scope 2, and the five mandatory Scope 3 categories required under PPN 006.

3. Emissions Reduction Targets

We project that carbon emissions will decrease to approximately 30 tCO₂e by 2040. This is a reduction of 10% against our 2024/25 baseline. We are committed to achieving net zero by 2050 for our UK operations.

4. Emissions Reduction Measures

Upstream Transport	We will explore options to reduce the emissions associated with inbound logistics, including investigating the feasibility of transitioning from air to sea freight, consolidating shipments, and optimising packaging.
Business Travel	We will encourage the use of public transport and rail for business travel where practical, and will review taxi and car usage to identify opportunities to reduce journeys or switch to lower-emission alternatives.
Employee Commuting	We will encourage employees to use public transport and walking for their commute. Our central London location provides excellent access to public transport links, making low-emission commuting the most practical option for the majority of our team. We will conduct an annual employee commuting survey to measure commuting patterns and identify further opportunities to reduce emissions.
Office Energy	We will encourage energy-conscious behaviours in the office, including powering down equipment when not in use. When renewing or relocating office space, green energy credentials and EPC rating will be a formal assessment criterion in our selection process.
Carbon Offsetting	For residual emissions that cannot be eliminated through operational changes, we will purchase Gold Standard or Verra-certified carbon credits.

5. Director Sign-Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 006 and the associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans. Baseline emissions are reported for the first time in this plan and are equal to our current reporting period emissions. The plan has been reviewed and approved at director level. Vatix Limited confirms that the information set out herein is accurate to the best of our knowledge and that we are committed to achieving net zero and delivering the reduction measures described in this plan.
